SPECIAL EVENTS

DEVOTIONAL GROUPS

Student groups composed of a cross-section of sixth, seventh and eighth grader boy and girl groups attend each day before first period.

HILL COUNTRY DAILY BREAD MINISTRIES

Students participate in projects and collections that benefit Hill Country Daily Bread Ministries throughout the year.

EagleFest is a Geneva Community Life (GCL) fundraiser made possible through parent volunteers. It is an afternoon of fun and games, and GCL uses the funds raised to bless teachers and the Geneva campus.

CHRISTMAS PROGRAM

Fine arts students present at an evening concert.

TOLKIEN DAY

Teachers and students dress as hobbits, dwarves and elves to celebrate J.R.R. Tolkien. This half-day event includes food and games facilitated by parent volunteers who help plan, decorate, serve food, organize games and more.
