LOGIC SCHOOL

There are three main types of dress in Logic School: Standard Dress (worn two days a week), P.E. Dress (worn two days a week) and Assembly Dress (worn once a week). MONDAY: DRESS UNIFORM

Worn once a week with plain white or navy socks (no logo) and brown or black leather shoes. Girls' skirts should be no higher than the 3.375" width of a credit card from the top of the knee.



TUESDAY AND THURSDAY: P.E. UNIFORM

Worn two times a week with plain white socks (no logo) and any tennis shoes



WEDNESDAY AND FRIDAY: STANDARD UNIFORM

Worn twice a week with plain navy or white socks (no logo) and brown or black leather shoes. Girls' skirts should be no higher than the 3.375" width of a credit card from the top of the knee.

** Please note: P.E. sweatshirts may not be worn on Standard Uniform days.



WHEN ANNOUNCED: JEANEVA OR SPIRIT DRESS

Any Geneva t-shirt or sweatshirt and jeans with shoes or boots (no clogs, sandals or crocs). A student may choose to follow the Standard Uniform guidelines on these days.
